The Lord's Pantry of Downingtown has been in operation for over 50 years and is a non-profit, 501(c)(3). Since its inception, the Lord's Pantry has been, and remains, 100% volunteer.

We currently serve 700 registered families a six to seven day supply of food which includes non-perishables, meat selections, vegetables and dairy products, laundry detergent, paper products, toiletries and donated pet food.
